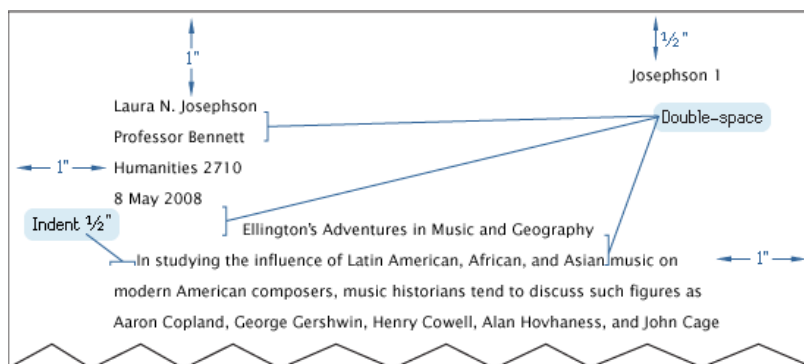


Quick MLA Reference Sheet

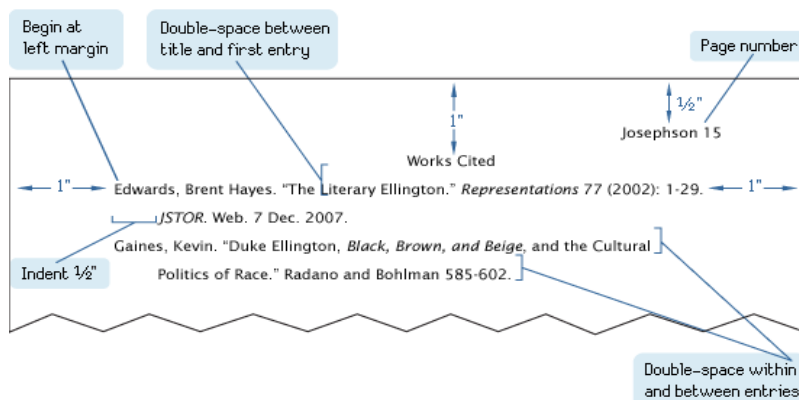
Paper Format

- Times New Roman
- Double spaced
- 1" margin
- Running Header with last name & page number
- Work cited page at the end.
- Intext or Parenthetical citation inside the text.



Work cited Page Format

- 1 inch margins and Work cited at top center
- Entries should be in alphabetical order by first letter of each entry.

BOOK:

Author's Last Name, First Name. Book Title. Place of Publication: Publisher, Publication Date.

Lee, Harper. To Kill a Mockingbird. New York: Warner Books, 1982

JOURNAL ARTICLE FROM DATABASE:

Author's Last name, First Name, "Article title." Journal Publication Date: Volume #. Data base. Name and city of subscribing library. Date accessed.

Schaller, George. B. "Realm of the Snow Antelope." Natural History May 1996: 48. MASUltra School Edition. EBSCOhost. La Salle High School, Milwaukie, OR. 15 Apr. 2003.

WEBSITE:

Author's Name. Web Page Title. Sponsoring Organization or Institution, Update or Last Date. Access Date.

Reid-Walsh, Jacqueline. Jane Austen Home Page. University of Wisconsin. 30 Mar. 2001.

Intext or Parenthetical citation format

- Intext citation is placed at the end of the sentence and indicates where the information came from.
- It is placed before the period.
- It should include author's name and page. Ex: (Townsend 10)
- If citation does not have author name include title and page number. Ex. (Northwest 122).
